

Log Into Your Fusion Account as an AT&T / FirstNet User (SNAP Authentication) SiyataSD7

Important: Before proceeding, determine if your device has a FirstNet or AT&T SIM. If yes, you should log in via SNAP authentication, which allows fast, automatic user authentication to the Fusion service by reading SIM data.

Also make sure to:

1. Have the last firmware according to **Siyata_SD7_Fusion_Firmware upgrade procedures** guide.
2. Request the Fusion app to be loaded on the device according to **Siyata_SD7_Fusion request and installation** guide.

Next, confirm that your organization administrator has assigned you a Fusion license and created your account. Once your setup is complete, make sure to have your ATT SIM in the device to log in using AT&T / FirstNet SNAP Authentication.

While logging in, you can see the messages Loading, Confirming, Authenticating, and Synchronizing on the screen.



No action required

If Wi-Fi is enabled on the device, the app tries to get the phone number from the device and log in using that number. If the process is not successful, try again after disabling the Wi-Fi.
